Regency Christian Academy is an educational ministry of South Orlando Baptist Church. Our programs operate as Full-time Preschool (ages 2-3), Voluntary Pre-Kindergarten (age 4), Elementary School (Kindergarten through 5th grade) and Middle School (6th -8th grades). Eligibility for a class depends on the birthday of the child. Children must be 5 on or before September 1, 2015 in order to enroll for Kindergarten. Likewise, a child must be 2 on or before September 1, 2015 to enroll in the PS-2 class, age 3 on or before September 1, 2015 to enroll in the PS-3 class, etc.

Elementary, and Middle School classes operate on a 10-month schedule *similar* to Orange County Public Schools. RCA is closed for major holidays and teacher workdays during the year. Winter Break Camp will not be available for the 2015-16 school year, but Spring Break Camp and Summer Camp are made available to all RCA students at an additional cost. A school calendar, as well as a Parent & Student Handbook will be provided with the enrollment packet on the school website. The first day of school for the 2015-2016 school year has been set for Monday, August 24, 2015.

Preschool childcare will not be provided for the 2 week winter break for the 2015-2016 school year; annual fees reflect 50 weeks rather than 52.

TUITION DISCOUNTS (Only one discount may be applied *per family*.)

Church Member Discount - 15% discount on all children enrolled for tuition only.

Sibling Discount - If siblings are enrolled, a 15% discount can be taken on additional child(ren)'s tuition only.

Full Payment Discount – Parents of enrolled students may pay the full balance of yearly tuition by August 24, and receive a 5% discount on tuition only.

Each discount excludes extended day, the VPK wrap around program, fees other than tuition, and cannot be used with any other discount.

Book and Supply Fees are nonrefundable beginning August 2015.

Tuition Fees are not prorated for holidays, absences, teacher planning days, etc.

Furthermore, RCA reserves the right to combine different consecutive grade level classes based on enrollment.

However, they will have separate instruction for core curriculum.

CURRICULUM & GOALS

- to guide children into a lifelong love of learning about Jesus Christ and His wonderful creation.
- to provide an academically superior education for preschoolers, elementary and middle school students.
- to model and train children to become leaders of integrity through Bible-based character development.

We use Christian academic curriculum materials from both Bob Jones University Press (www.bjupress.com) and A Beka (www.abeka.com) along with many supplemental ideas and materials provided by our teachers. We also plan weekly chapel meetings for all students. Periodic educational field trips are planned for VPK to Eighth Grade with special in-house activities (field day, traveling zoos, reading events, etc.) for all students. Preschool & Elementary students participate in weekly classes of Art, P.E., Music, and our unique Praise in Motion program along with weekly visits to our Library. Middle School students will be involved in Art, P.E., Spanish, as well as other educational and life electives. Computers and/or an iPad are provided in each classroom for teacher and student use. Elementary and Middle School students also visit the MAC Computer Lab on a weekly basis.

MEALS

A well-balanced lunch will be provided for all children in our Full-time Preschool program. Lunch is also available to Elementary students at an additional cost paid in advance. Any child who wishes to bring his/or her own well-balanced lunch to school may do so. Lunches are currently being offered through SLA Management, a local food service company whom we have worked with since spring 2003.

OTHER RCA PROGRAMS

Extended Day is available to RCA students before and after school at a cost of \$60.00 per week. Morning Extended Day only is available for \$15.00/week and Afternoon Extended Day only is available for \$55.00/week. The weekly fee for Extended Day is required regardless of the amount of time attended by the student and is not prorated for holidays, absences, teacher planning days, etc. Our Extended Day program is available from 7:00 a.m. to 8:15 a.m. (before school) and 3:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m. (after school). Extended day fees bill a week in advance and are due each Monday. Extended Day fees must be paid by 6:00 pm on Thursday to prevent a late payment fee being charged.

Extracurricular Programs are available for students with start-up and activity fees related to the expense of these programs. These may include Dance: Ballet, Jazz, Tap; Sports: basketball, flag football, soccer; Honor Society, Student Council, etc...More information is on the RCA Website: www.rcaschool.com. WITHDRAWAL FEES

Regency Christian Academy is a non-profit organization setting each year's budget on students contracted for that year. Because early termination and withdrawal of students results in damages which are difficult to adequately assess, a Withdrawal Fee of \$530.00 will be required of any Middle School student, \$510.00 of any Elementary School student, \$520.00 of any Full time Preschool student who withdraws before the end of the school year May 28, 2016. **To avoid this Withdrawal Fee a written intent, giving 30 days advanced notice to the child's last day, must be turned in to the school office.** Additional fees for late pick-up and late payments will be explained in the enrollment paperwork. Book and supply fees are nonrefundable at any time during the school year.

REGISTRATION

You may pick up an Enrollment Packet from the RCA school office or register online: www.rcaschool.com. However, to reserve a spot for your child for the 2015-2016 school year, we must receive the Enrollment packet with all forms completed and the appropriate Registration Fee.

In-House Enrollment: Tuesday, January 20, 2015- Friday, February 6, 2015. (Only families with children currently attending Regency Christian Academy or South Orlando Baptist Church may enroll.) From January 20 through February 6 the Registration Fee is reduced to \$75.00. As of Monday, February 9, the Registration Fee will return to the regular published amount of \$150.00. **No exceptions will be made.**

Open Enrollment:** Begins Monday, February 9, 2015 – Friday, February 20, 2015. (Registration Fee will be Reduced with printed coupon from the RCA website.)

****ATTENTION NEW STUDENTS:**

Grade Readiness Assessments *are* required for incoming Elementary/Middle School students who did not attend RCA during the 2014-2015 school year at a cost of \$25. All students coming from other schools going into K-5 through 8th Grade must provide a copy of their most current report cards (final marking period shown). Interviews, if needed, will be scheduled through the school office.

Shot records, Physical forms, and Copy of Birth Certificate are due for all new students.
