Scholar Diploma Designation

In addition to meeting the 24-credit standard high school diploma requirements, a student must meet the following requirements:

- Earn 1 credit in Algebra II.
- Earn 1 credit in statistics or an equally rigorous mathematics course.
- Earn 1 credit in chemistry or physics.
- Earn 1 credit in a course equally rigorous to chemistry or physics.
- Earn 2 credits in the same world language.
- Earn at least 1 credit in AP or a dual enrollment course.
- Takes the respective AP assessment; and
- Earns the minimum score to earn college credit.

Standard Diploma Designation

Meet the standard high school diploma requirements.

State University System (SUS)

Admission into Florida's public universities is competitive. Prospective students should complete a rigorous curriculum in high school and apply to more than one university to increase their chance for acceptance. To qualify to enter one of Florida's public universities, a first time-in-college student must meet the following minimum requirements:

- High school graduation with a standard diploma
- Admission test scores
- 16 credits of approved college preparatory academic courses
- 4 English (3 with substantial writing)
- 4 Mathematics (Algebra I level and above)
- 3 Natural Science (2 with substantial lab)
- 3 Social Science
- 2 World Language (sequential, in the same language)
- 2 approved electives
